DAVID PUT ON HIS EPHOD!



Every day and in so many ways life down here tries to tear us away from the Lord.

The cares of this life reach out their many arms and grab hold of our time, hearts, minds and occupy the inner chambers that belong to the King. The needs of this life press their demands and try to hold our hearts hostage until their requirements are met... which usually involves an allegiance to them above Jesus. Trials and tribulations, failures and defeats come to us with all with their anxiety and fear like chains ready to wrap around our hearts and hold us captive to their circumstances in the earth. Yet in the midst of such obstacles, and so many more... David put on his ephod, went into the Holy Place (a tent in his backyard where God dwelt) and (in so many words) cried out "Reign Lord Jesus, Reign"! (2 Sam. 6:14 -15, 17; Psa. 27).

An ephod is the garment that the Priests of the Old Testament wore when they went into the Presence of the Lord to minister to Him (Exo. 28:4; 1 Sam. 2:18, 28).

They clothed themselves in that which said to the Lord, "I am here to minister to You. Period." Let the Love begin! The ephod was what a priest put on as he prepared himself to separate from the people and the issues and simply immerse himself into God and minister to Him (Exo. 28:4).

Time and again you will find David in the midst of trial and despair and instead of clothing himself in panic and strife to fix his problems and calm his own soul, He put on the ephod and sought God instead of his own needs (1 Sam. 23:9, 30:6-8). Granted, there are also many times in the scriptures when David's soul was ungoverned and God brought him on a journey from being clothed with soul-strife to the Ephod life of Love for God (Psa. 62, 116). And so, there is hope for me... for all of us! It is a process of growing in our relationship with the Lord. It is a journey from me to Him. From the issues of the earth to the issues of His heart. We can weep before our situations, or we can dance in the midst of them before our King ... knowing that He is in control, He is Lord and He is the Lamb Who is our Life.

All things work together for the good of being conformed to His image ... But only to those who "put on their ephod" and love Him (Rom. 8:28-29).

God has given us garments of praise instead of a spirit of heaviness (Isa. 61:3). God did that when He GAVE US HIMSELF! God is in us... we shall not be moved by the ever-changing earth, but rather moved by that river of Life in us that makes glad the city of God (Psa. 46:4-5).
