## Downpatrick Head



Dun Briste, a spectacular sea-stack, estimated to be approximately 50 meters in height, stands 80 meters off Downpatrick Head, in Co. Mayo, Ireland. Fire Ministries' Irish headquarters' location is about a 15 minute drive away from this lovely landmark.

The name Downpatrick is derived from a time when St Patrick himself founded a church here. You can still see the ruins of the church building, a stone cross and well there today.
