The "Mary's" Who Were With The Lord

Dear Sisters in the Lord,

This little email is about how women were with the Lord in His death, burial and resurrection. What an incredible privilege and intimacy to be with the Lord in these times of great and eternal significance. To be able to share with Him and care for Him in these deep hours. The scriptures show us three "Mary's" that were with the Lord in such a way. One Mary was with the Lord in preparation for His burial. This is Mary of Bethany (Martha's sister) found in John 12:3-7. This Mary anointed the Lord to prepare Him for His burial(verse 7). So much could be said about the incredible sensitivity and awareness this woman must have had to be able to understand the time of death that Jesus was about to enter into, and to be with Him in preparation for it. She was the first human being to carry the message that Jesus was risen from the dead to mankind!!! This was a woman of low stature but with a big heart that could not bear the thought of living without

Jesus, and He appeared to her first! (John 20:1-18).

All of these "Mary's" together represent the one corporate Bride that we all are together. They show us that our place is with the Lord in His death, burial and resurrection. Jesus does not want to be alone during any of these times, and now that we are His very Body we can bear His dying and His living from within. His "Mary" is the place from where He now lives and the vessel through whom He continues to give His life. Praise God for Him including us in Himself in these ways! May we bless the Lord at all times as we abide in Him and let Him abide in us through all the seasons of His Cross.
